Dr. Casey Crabill is the President of Raritan Valley Community College. Prior to joining RVCC, she served as president of the College of the Redwoods in Eureka, California for seven years.

From September 1998 to July 1999, she served as acting president of Gateway Community College in New Haven, Connecticut, a two-campus, urban community college. She also chaired a statewide committee charged with revamping the academic delivery system of the state's community colleges.

She served as acting president of Quinebaug Valley Community College in Danielson, Connecticut and also two years as dean of Learning and Student Development. Crabill spent four years at Dundalk Community College in Dundalk, Maryland from 1991 to 1995. During that time, she served as division chair for Academic Development and Learning Support, managing staffing, budget and curriculum and program development.

Crabill began her career as a lecturer of English at the State University of New York at Albany. She went on to become a teacher of English as a Second Language at the TASIS England American School in Surrey, England and a program evaluator at the Berkshire Farms Center and Services for Youth in Canaan, New York.

She received her B.A. in English from Skidmore College and an M.S. in Teaching English as a Second Language and an Ed.D. in Curriculum and Instruction both from the State University of New York at Albany.
